By using our new GenFlex® Plus Thermoplastic (TPO and PVC) membranes (72 mil or greater) you can offer your customers warranty coverage against unintentional punctures, hailstones of less than 2”, and high wind gusts up to 100 mph. For additional system requirements refer to the GenFlex Warranty Reference Guide.

Whether the specifications call for different single ply roofing systems or warranty periods, the GenFlex Warranty Reference Guide is a good tool to confirm system requirements and warranty coverage. In addition, the guide also provides the warranty fee charged for both standard roofing systems and high wind roofing systems.

Please note the GenFlex® Edge Metal system is now mandatory for all high wind warranties that require 90 mph or greater wind gust coverage, and on our new GenFlex Plus roofing systems. GenFlex® Edge Metal products comply with IBC 2003 Building Codes and are available in a variety of designs, gauges and colors to match your Architectural and performance requirements for both edge and coping metals.
