GenFlex FlexWhite Clear Primer is an adhesion promoter designed to clean and prime GenFlex FlexWhite EPDM or TPO membranes prior to application of FlexWhite Peel & Stick<sup>™</sup> accessories, FlexWhite Clear Primer must be applied with a Scrub Pad and Handle.

# Installation

Refer to current GenFlex Technical Specifications for additional instructions.

#### IMPORTANT: Ensure the receiving surfaces are free of debris and no moisture is present.

- 1. Thoroughly mix GenFlex Clear Primer. DO NOT THIN! A minimum of 2 minutes of vigorous hand mixing with a wooden paint stirrer or its equivalent is required. All sources of ignition should be eliminated; adequate ventilation should exist.
- 2. Clean all surfaces with a clean cotton rag and Cleaner, removing excess contamination prior to application of the primer.
- 3. With a scrub pad and handle, apply GenFlex Clear Primer, using long and continuous back and forth strokes with heavy to moderate pressure, along the bonding area until no streaks or puddling occurs.
- 4. Allow GenFlex Clear Primer to dry until slightly tacky to a dry finger touch.
- 5. Proceed with application of Peel & Stick accessory as required by current product specifications.

## Storage

Store indoors in original unopened containers at a temperature between 60° F and 80° F (16° C and 27° C) for maximum shelf life. Do not store on roof in direct sunlight. When exposed to lower temperatures, restore to room temperature prior to use.

## Shelf Life

12 months; shelf life will be shortened if exposed to elevated temperatures.
